

In Literacy, we will be learning to write persuasive & discursive (discussion) texts. We will also write some short stories in different genres. Our spelling and grammar focus will be on word types, phrases, clauses and punctuation.

In Numeracy, our key skills focus will be on negative numbers and a continued focus on written methods of calculation and applying our core skills to increasingly complex word problems. We will also recap on fractions including adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing proper and improper fractions and mixed numbers.

In Jewish Studies, we will be applying our monthly values to the Chumash narrative, learning a new Tefillot and preparing for Chanukah. In Hebrew, our topic will be "Hobbies" which includes different clubs that children like to go to, verbs associated with the topic and a survey of favourite hobbies.

In Humanities our focus is on the Victorian Era covering the Industrial revolution and the lives of children during this period of British history.

Our Topic this half term is the Victorian Era.

Our Science work will be on the classification of vertebrates and the human body (with a focus on the circulatory system and skeleton).

In PSHCE we will be discussing the impact and causes of bullying and how to combat it.

In RE we will be celebrating multiculturalism and religious tolerance.

In Pe, we will be developing our flexibility, coordination and team work through dance.

In Art, we will be creating art through the use of different fabrics and shapes

In ICT, we will be focussing on developing our ICT skills to make presentations and to research topics in other curriculum areas.
