

In Literacy we will continue to focus on sentence writing to extend sentences using connectives and descriptive vocabulary. Our spelling and grammar focus will continue to focus on using our phonics words and sounds correctly in our independent writing. We will be writing fiction and non fiction sentences about animals. We will be reading stories such as Owl Babies and Harry the Dirty Dog.

In Numeracy we will be continuing counting in 1's, 2's, 5's and 10's. We will be writing number words for numerals.

We will be learning to read o'clock and half past times on the clock and using this to solve time problems.

In Jewish Studies we will be focussing on the content and messages of the weekly Torah portion, brushing up on our Hebrew Reading skills and preparing for Chanukah.

In Humanities our focus is on Geography. We will be exploring the local area and creating maps to follow.

## Our Topic this half term is Animals

In Science we will be learning to identify and classify all the animals from the Garden of Eden into mammals, reptiles, fish amphibians and birds.

In RE we will be learning about how Hindu people celebrate the Hindu festivals of Divali and Holi.

In PSHCE we will be talking about how we stay safe at school and in the wider world.

In Pe we will be learning football skills including dribbling, passing, shooting and scoring. We will be making up aiming and scoring games. Later we will be learning to make up simple dances to the book "We're Going on a Bear Hunt."

In ICT we will be learning the basic functions of the laptop and how we can use these to support our learning.
