Year 3 Trip: The Science Museum

Whole school trip to the Oval Cricket ground

In Literacy we will be learning about adventure stories, persuasive writing and free verse poetry.

Our spelling and grammar focus will be the statutory words for Year 3

Our core text this term will be the story of Varmints and What the Romans did for us.

In Numeracy our key skills focus will be on adding and subtraction, multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8

We will also be focusing on measures of length and weight and telling the time including quarter past and quarter to

In Jewish Studies we will be focussing on learning about Yom Ha'atzmaut & Shavuot. The children will continue their studies of Ivrit.

In Humanities our focus is on Ancient Rome



Our Science work will be continuing on Forces and magnetism

In RE and PSHCE we will be learning about What can we learn from the Bible?, In PSHCE, we will be looking at You and me, How to resolve conflict? See other's point of view

In PE and Art/DT we will be working on Cricket (including a trip to the Oval). For art we will be looking at mosaics

In ICT we will be looking at internet safety coding and debugging algorithms
