The media have announced schools performance data today and I wanted to share Simon Mark's amazing results. Here's a snap shot of the published headline data.

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So... the percentage of our pupils who passed Reading, Writing and Maths at the expected standard, in all three subjects was 83%. When compared to the local authority's average of 71% and in England the pass rate for all three subjects was 64%. This places Simon Marks 12% higher than local results and 19% higher in National results. This is quite an achievement for our school!

When we look at the bottom graph we can see that our pupils also outperformed both local and national averages at getting the 'higher scores' and reaching the higher standard, we outperformed the local authority average by 9% and we outperformed the national average by 12%.

For the first time we are now graded as 'Well above Average' for progress scores in Reading, Writing and Maths. There is a more detailed breakdown of our schools performance on the link below.
