Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to the first half term of the New Year. We would like to share our Curriculum overview with you and some key dates for this half term.

PE day is Monday: please ensure your child has their full PE kit with them.

Homework- will go out Thursday and pupils will be expected to return their homework to school on Tuesday. Please ensure all homework is complete and back at school in time.

Spelling test will take place every Friday.

Our Topic for this half term is 'Christopher Columbus'.

In Literacy we will be learning about nonchronological reports and free verse poems.

Our grammar focus will be on conjunctions, expanded noun phrases and suffixes.

In Art we will be learning about Vincent van Gogh and looking to recreate his famous sunflower painting.

In RE, we will learn about what it is like growing up in a Christian home.

In PSHCE, our theme is 'Let's work' and our focus for SEAL is about 'Going for Goals'.

In Numeracy our key skills focus will be on the four operations, time, geometry, fractions and problem solving.

Our Topic this half-term is Christopher Columbus

In Humanities, our focus is
History where we will be learning
about Christopher Columbus: a
study of his life and his
discovery of the new world.

In Jewish Studies, we will be focussing on the Jewish festivals of Tu B'Shevat, Purim and Pesach, as well as brushing up on our Tefillah skills.

Our Science work will be on Habitats. We will look at different habitats around the world

We will also be looking at how animals have adapted to suit their habitat.

In ICT, we will be using our computing skills to research the life of Christopher Columbus and create our own posters. We will learn how to copy and paste images to make our posters stand out.
