Welcome to Spring 2!

We would like to share our curriculum overview with you about all the exciting learning that we have coming up this term.

Please note:

- *PE day will be **Thursday** so please ensure you have your full PE kit in on these days including trainers.*
- *Homework will be handed out on a **Thursday** to be returned on a **Tuesday**. Children will receive literacy and numeracy homework as well as spellings. They are also expected to be reading daily and practising their times tables on Times Tables Rockstars.*

In Literacy, we are beginning this term by focusing on the picture book 'Flotsam'. We will be using this book to inspire some creative and persuasive writing linked to our 'Save our Planet' topic. We will be continuing to practise and revise our grammar skills within literacy lessons.

In Numeracy, we will be working on our daily arithmetic skills as well as moving onto geometry and ratio. In geometry, we will be learning about angle facts, 3D shapes and nets.

In Jewish Studies, we will be looking at the Megillah for Purim. We will also be preparing for Pesach and the Seder by learning about the order of Seder, the prayers and traditions in order to lead KS2 in the School Seder Meal.

Our art focus for this term will be sewing.

Our topic: Save our Planet!



In PE, our focus is badminton and team sports. We will be looking at the skills and rules needed for a successful game of badminton.

In RE, we will be looking at Christianity with a focus on Easter and Lent. In PSHE, our focus will be relationships, friendships and families.

In Humanities, our focus is 'Save our Planet' where we will be learning about sustainability in our lives and London. We will also be thinking about the use and impact of plastic and recycling before we take part in a recycling workshop.
