

Nursery Summer 2

Welcome to the second half of the Summer term.

This term will be a busy term for the children.

We would like to share the Nursery Curriculum overview.

Book bags – children will have the opportunity to take a book home to share with their family.

Out topic for this half term is 'On your marks!' We will be using songs and stories to explore this.

In Writing we will continue to practice writing our own names confidently. In Phonics we will practice finding the first sounds in words. We will consolidate blending and segmenting skills. In Reading we will share stories and rhymes with repeated phrases. In writing we will continue to Dance, Write and practice holding a pencil between thumb and two fingers.

We will continue to extend our counting to say the number names in order to ten then twenty. We will practice counting a number of objects making sure we say one number name for each object. We will separate things we count in different ways to recognise the total is the same. We will count things we cannot see and find the numeral. We will use different objects to compare which is the longest and which is the shortest.

In Communication and Language we will use new vocabulary around topic songs. We will ask and answer questions about what we have learned.

During Expressive Art and Design we will build on colour knowledge to mix, match and change colours. We will use different media – water colour, oil pastels and poster paint. Our Topic this half term is 'On your marks!'

In Physical Development we will use scissors safely to make snips, practise different ways of climbing, moving on the ground and over obstacles. We will observe the effect of activity on our bodies. In Understanding the World we will talk about special times or events for family and friends. We will look at equipment that can retrieve information, tell the time

and be programmed.

In Personal, Social and Emotional

Education we will talk about our

own feelings and that some of our

actions and words can hurt others'

feelings.

In Jewish studies we will attend weekly Shabbat assemblies. We will be learning about the festival Shavuot.
