

Curriculum Newsletter for Year One and Two Summer 2 2019

Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to the new term. We would like to share our Curriculum overview with you and some key dates for this half term.

PE day is Monday please ensure your child has their full PE kit with them.

Homework—and new reading books go out Tuesday and pupils will be expected to return their homework to school on the following Tuesday. Please ensure all homework is complete and back at school in time.

Spelling-words are given out with homework and tested on the Friday of the following week.

Our Topic for this half term is the 'seaside'

Please take a look at our Curriculum Map for this half term.

In Literacy we will be reading a range of stories about the seaside and non-ficton books. We will be writing our own stories and non chronological reports. We will continue to use our phonics knowledge to support spelling and our grammar skills to apply different types of punctuation.

In numeracy we will continue to focus on the 2, 5 and 10 times tables. We will be using our addition, subtraction, multiplication and division skills to solve problems with money. We will also continue to solve problems involving fractions.

In Jewish studies we will be listening to stories from the weekly parashat and using these as a basis for art and creative activities. We will also be talking about the values of the month and how we can apply these in our learning.

In geography we will be finding out about the seaside.

We will be locating the coastline on a map, finding out how seaside places differ from London and what there is to do at the seaside.

Our Topic this half term is the Seaside

In Science we will be learning about the seasons. We will be matching seasons to the months of the year, sorting and classifying living things according to the months we see them.

In RE we will be talking about what is important to us as children in a Jewish School.

In PSHCE we will be talking about how to keep healthy.

In PE we will be learning different skills to participate in sports day.

We will be playing games involving throwing, catching and aiming.

In ICT we will continue to use the app Purple
Mash to support other areas of the curriculum
and we will be using controllable Beebots to
learn about position and directions and
completing simple programming apps to
practice our coding skills.
