Welcome to Summer 2!

We would like to share our curriculum overview with you about all the exciting learning that we have coming up this term.

Please note:

- PE day will be **Thursday** so please ensure you have your full PE kit in on these days including trainers.
- Homework will be handed out on a **Thursday** to be returned on a **Tuesday**. Children will a literacy and numeracy task to complete. They are also expected to be reading daily and practising their times tables on Times Tables Rockstars.

In Literacy, we will begin by focusing on poetry, creating personification poems and taking inspiration from 'The Lost Words' which we will be publishing using ICT.

In Numeracy, we will be working on a variety of investigations involving number, patterns and shape. We will continue to work on our arithmetic skills as well as times tables.

In Jewish Studies this term, the children will be reviewing and consolidating their knowledge of the Chumash. They will also be investigating the holy temples built by Solomon and Herold.

Our topic:

Post-War Britain

In science, our topic is electricity. We will be constructing circuits using a variety of circuit components and investigating how a complete circuit is created.

Our art focus will be water colours to link in with our study of 'The Lost Words'.

In PE, we will be working on athletics skills in preparation for Sports Day.

In Humanities, our focus is World War II and post-war Britain. Following our studies of WWII, we will be considering how life in Britain changed after the war and why these changes occurred.

In PSHE, our focus will be 'Being Healthy' as well as transition to secondary school and how we are affected by changes in our lives.
