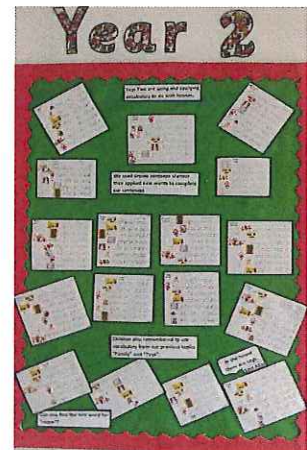

The children are learning about a variety of blessings which are said for different experiences through our lives and they have

learnt a series of important lessons which are taken from the weekly Torah portion read in the Synagogue.
