

Curriculum Newsletter for Years 3 & 4 Summer 1, 2022.

Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to the first half term of the Summer term. We would like to share our Curriculum overview with you and some key dates for this half term.

Swimming day is Wednesday; please ensure your child has their swimming kit with them.

PE day is Tuesday; please ensure your child has their full PE kit with them.

Homework—will go out on Thursday and pupils will be expected to return their homework to school on Tuesday. Please ensure all homework is complete and back at school in time.

Our Topic for this half term is 'Rules and Morals..

In Literacy we will be learning about fables, focusing on Aesop's fables. We will also be looking at conjunctions and speech punctuation.

In PE, we will be working on Athletics and the field events involving throwing, including javelin and discus.

For Design & Technology, we will be looking at architecture, examining two key buildings — the Parthenon and St Paul's Cathedral and compare the two as well as looking at the architects behind the buildings.

Our Science, work will be on Rocks and Soil. . We will learn about different types of rocks and their properties and how they are formed.

In Numeracy our key skills focus will be on word problems and fractions and decimals. We will also be looking at measures including, length, mass and time. Mental arithmetic, will focus on times tables.



Our Topic this half term is

Rules and Morals

In RE, we will learn about Forgiveness and comparing the different viewpoints of Judaism and Hinduism.

In PHSCE/RSE, our theme is the rules of internet safety and how to behave online.

This term in Jewish Studies the children will be learning about Israel, Customs for Shavuot as well as Psalms, which appear early in the morning services, opening with Baruch SheAmar and closing with Yishtabach. Ivrit lessons will be looking at writing in script.

In Humanities, our focus is
History where we will be learning
about the Magna Carta. It looks
at the background to its creation
and the reasons behind
disputes. It then encourages
consideration of the impact of
it in relation to the law.

In Computing, we will be learning about spreadsheets and how to use them.

In Music the pupils will be exploring composition and composing their own piece of music
