



## Curriculum Newsletter for Years 3 & 4 Summer 2, 2022.

Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to the last half term of the Summer term. We would like to share our Curriculum overview with you and some key dates for this half term.

Swimming day is Wednesday; please ensure your child has their swimming kit with them.

PE Kit – Could your child bring their PE kit in on Monday and bring it home on Friday

Homework will go out on Thursday and pupils will be expected to return their homework to school on Tuesday. Please ensure all homework is complete and back at school in time.

Our Topic for this half term is 'Change'.

In Literacy we will read, analyse, perform and write our own kenning poems. We will also be reading 'The Mysteries of Harris Burdick' and work on creating atmosphere in our setting descriptions and dialogue.

In Numeracy our key skills focus will be on word problems and money as well as graphs and tables. Mental arithmetic, will focus on times tables and division facts.

This term in Jewish Studies the children will be learning about Messilat Lashem - Brachot of Shema and the ideas and importance behind it. They will also continue learning about the weekly Parasha. Ivrit lessons will be looking at understanding simple conversations writing in script.

In PE, we will be working on outdoor team games including rounders, football and preparing for Sports Day. .

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For Art we will be looking at still life images. This encourages pupils to closely examine works of art, encouraging pupils to develop skills associated with this form of art.

In Humanities, our focus is Geography where we will be learning about farming and our changing environment.

In Science, we will be learning about the parts of plants and flowers. We will also look at the conditions in which plants grow best.

In RE, we will learn about the different foods and the laws surrounding them for different religions and comparing the differences between Jewish, Muslim and Hindu rules.

In Computing, we will be learning about coding and writing algorithms.

In PHSCE/RSE, our theme is changes and how we change including looking at relationships. .

In Music we will be exploring characteristics of singing games. We will sing and play a selection of traditional and contemporary singing games.
