It was quite a mess and historical water damage had certainly left its mark.



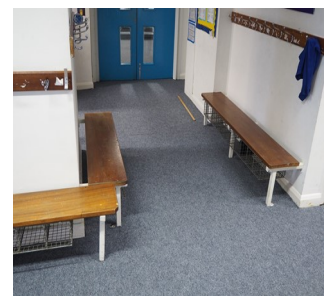
It was not a pleasant library area!
