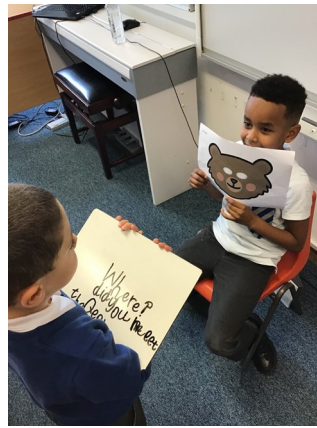

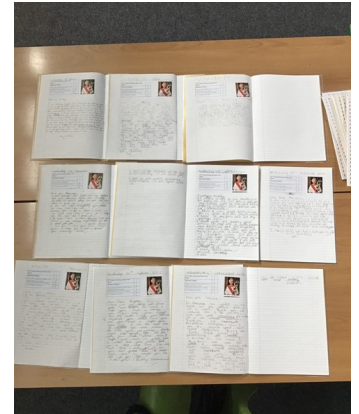

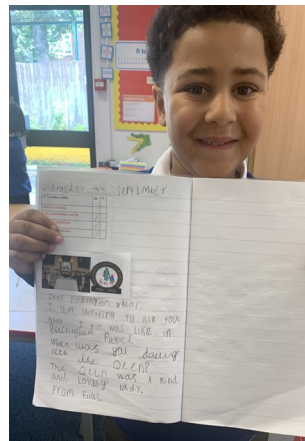
In year one and two pupils wrote letters to Paddington Bear asking him about what it was like to meet the Queen.



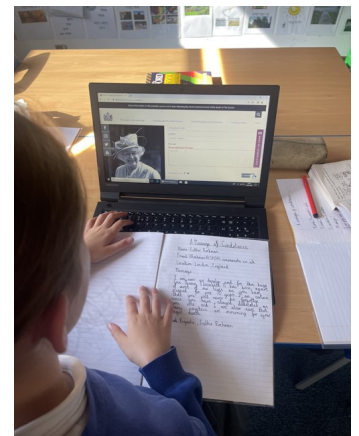
Years five and six undertook some research work and looked at significant pieces of work the Queen had done over her 70year reign and put these on a timeline.
