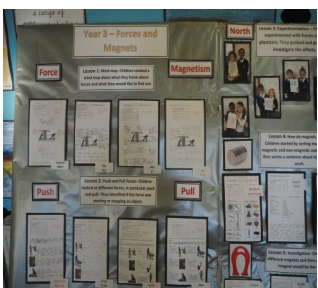

Early years explored waterproof materials whilst years 1 and 2 looked at how to best protect eggs.

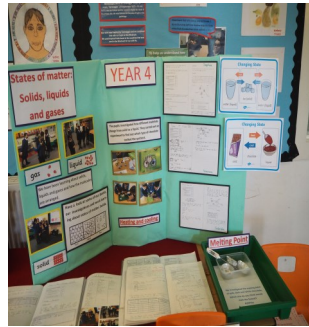


Year 3 undertook investigations on forces and magnets.
