

Curriculum Newsletter for EYFS Autumn 1 2024

Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to the First term in Reception and Nursery. We would like to share our Curriculum overview with you and some key dates for this half term.

PE day will be Tuesday. Please ensure your child has their full PE kit with them, navy or black shorts or jogging bottoms, white t-shirt and black plimsoles.

Homework and reading books go out Thursday and pupils will be expected to return their homework to school on the following Tuesday. Please ensure all homework is complete and back at school in time in your child's bookbag.

Our Topic for this half term is 'All About Me.'

In Literacy we will be learning our Phase 2 letter sounds and begin using them to read short words. We will be reading books about Jewish Festivals and about ourselves. We will be focussing on letter formation to help us write our names, labels and short words.

In Mathematics we will be playing lots of counting games to practise our counting skills. We will be ordering numbers up to five and then, ten and beyond and comparing numbers and amounts to identify which is more and less.

In PSED, we will be creating and learning to follow our class rights and responsibilities. We will be talking about when we need to say sorry. We will be thinking about how we are special and what we want to learn in our class this year.

We will be learning new words to describe ourselves, our appearance, the senses, likes and dislikes and our family.

Our Topic this half term is 'All About Me'

In Understanding the World we will be talking about our families and what we like to do. For Rosh Hashanah, we will be examining how apples look, feel and taste and finding out about bees and where honey comes from.

In Expressive Art and Design, we will be learning to how to use paintbrushes and scissors independently to create our own paintings and crafts. In Music, the children will be listening to music that represents the season and beginning to use musical vocabulary to describe it.

To support Physical Development, we will be using writing tools to make letter shapes and draw pictures with increasing control. Outdoors we will be building with large blocks and learning how to use the climbing apparatus safely.

We will be reading stories to describe the Jewish Festivals of Rosh Hashanah, Yom Kippur, Sukkot and Simchat Torah. We will be learning the stories of Creation and Noah.

In Ivrit we will be learning songs and key words for each festival.
