Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to the first half term of summer. We would like to share our Curriculum overview with you and some key dates for this half term.

<u>PE</u> will take place on Wednesday; please ensure your child has their full PE kit with them and running shoes for the 'Daily Mile'.

In Literacy we will be learning about narrative writing and our class text will be Rastamouse.

Our grammar focus will be on expanded noun phrases and speech marks, as well as building our vocabulary.

In PE we will be participating in team games, developing simple tactics for attacking and defending.

In Art, we will be learning about collages. We will explore collage and cut outs as a way to represent our ideas.

In RE, we will learn about Sikhism, in particular the 5 K's.

In PSHCE, our theme is growing and changing. We will look at the changes that occur in our life.

In Numeracy our key skills focus will be on the four operations, measures, geometry, fractions, problem solving, challenges and investigations.
