Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back! We hope that you all had an enjoyable break and are looking forward to the new school year. We would like to share our curriculum overview with you about all the great learning that we have coming up this term. This year, in Year 6, the adults in the class will be Mr Hakan and Miss Sev.

<b>In Literacy, we will start by looking at the story of Winnie the Pooh. We will be analyzing the story and writing a newspaper article based on a chapter from the book. After that, our core text will be ‘The arrival’ where we will be creating our own version of the story.</b>	In Numeracy, we will start by focusing on number and place value, negative numbers and the four operations. We will be building on our previous learning before applying these skills to reasoning and problem solving. We’ll be working on our arithmetic and our 2-12 times tables daily.	Our first computing focus will be programming using Scratch to make our own games. We will also use our computing skills across a range of other subjects.	In PHSCE/RSE, our focus will be rights and responsibilities and democracy. We will be thinking about our roles and responsibilities for the New Year, both in and out of the classroom.	In Science, children will build on their understanding of animals including humans. We will look at the circulatory system as well as the effect of exercise on the heart.
Topic	Ivrit	Art	P.E	Jewish Studies
<b>Our history focus is ‘The Vikings and Anglo Saxons’. This unit of work explores the Vikings and where they came from. We will be looking at their diet and how they influenced the world.</b>	In Ivrit, our focus is vocabulary associated with festivals, the classroom and winter clothes.	In Art, we will create a piece of art in the style of William Morris.	In PE, our focus is basketball. We will learn and practice the required skills and rules before applying these to full games.	In Jewish Studies we will be working on our Hebrew reading and learning about the upcoming Jewish festivals including Rosh Hashanah, Yom Kippur, Sukkot, Simchat Torah and Shemini Atzeret.
